


HOW TO EXPORT TO SKETCHFAB:

1 – In the main menu select "Export to Sketchfab..."



- ☐ This menu item is enabled if the current scene contains at least one mesh...
- 2 The first time you try to export a model to Sketchfab, the (*CONNEXION TO SKETCHFAB) window will be displayed. Once you have correctly entered your Sketchfab login information you will be immediately redirected to the export window.



If you don't have a Sketchfab account, you can select "Create a new Sketchfab account" to be redirected to the Sketchfab registration page.

After you've created a new Sketchfab account, enter your Sketchfab username (which is an email address) and your password.


Then click on "Login".

- 3 After logging in the "EXPORT TO SKETCHFAB" window is displayed. In this window:
 - Enter a Title
 - Enter an (optional) description
 - Enter optional Tags (separated by space characters) ie. Akeytsu
 - Select a category
 - Check "Publish as draft" if your do not want your model to be public


Note: you can change the Sketchfab account via the "Change Sketchfab account" link at the top of the screen which will then display the "CONNEXION TO SKETCHFAB" screen.



4 – When you've filled in the information on the Export to Sketchfab screen, click on "Upload". If you're not already logged in to a Sketchfab account, a browser window will appear asking you to connect to Sketchfab.



If you're already connected, the uploaded model window will open in your Internet browser



- $\hfill\Box$ If Akeytsu Sketchfab's account is account 1, but Sketchfab's browser is connected to account 2
 - your model will be uploaded to account1
 - the browser will open in account2 (where you'll see your uploaded model if it is public)
